



PUBLIC NOTICE REGARDING THE OPENING OF A TENDER FOR THE AWARD OF ONE RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP (BI) TO A MASTER RESEARCHER ENROLLED IN A NON-DEGREE COURSE WITHIN THE PROJECT “PARENTING 4 ALL - ESTUDO DE EFETIVIDADE E DE IMPLEMENTAÇÃO DO PROGRAMA PARENTAL ACT- RAISING SAFE KIDS COM PAIS E MÃES EM SITUAÇÃO DE RECLUSÃO” (REF.ª 36030), FUNDED BY THE CALOUSTE GULBENKIAN FOUNDATION, UNDER AXIS II OF THE INITIATIVE GROWING MINDS – AFFECTIVE BONDING AND DEVELOPMENT.

Public notice regarding the award of a Research Fellowship - Master enrolled in a non-academic degree course¹

Ref. FPUL/BI/2026/01

One Research Fellowship (BI) for a master researcher enrolled in a non-degree course is available at the Faculdade de Psicologia da Universidade de Lisboa (Faculty of Psychology, University of Lisbon), within the Project “Parenting 4 All - Estudo de Efetividade e de Implementação do Programa Parental ACT- Raising Safe Kids com Pais e Mães em Situação de Reclusão”, (Ref.ª 36030), funded by the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation, under Axis II of the initiative Growing Minds – Affective Bonding And Development, under the following terms and conditions:

A. Scientific Domain: Clinical and Health Psychology

Mandatory admission criteria:

1. Master degree in Child and Adolescent Developmental Psychopathology or Clinical and Health Psychology, with a minimum master's final grade of 16;
2. Registration and enrolment in a non-degree course in areas relevant to the research project.
This condition will be verified by the date of signing the contract;
3. Immediate availability.

In addition, the applicant enrolled in a non-degree course offered by a higher education institution must cumulatively fulfil the following requirement [Article 8 of the current Regulation of Research Fellowships of the University of Lisbon (Order No. 6238/2020, of June 12 and amended by Order No. 8061/2022, of July 1)]:

- By signing the fellowship contract in question, including any renewals, the Research Fellow will not exceed an accumulated period of one year in this type of fellowship, consecutively or

interpolated. This will be verified by a declaration of honour sent by the applicant with the application.

NB: Applicants who do not fulfil the above mandatory admission criteria will be excluded outright. The requirement determined under point 2 of the admission criteria will be verified until the date the contract is signed.

B. Preferential admission criteria:

1. Knowledge and experience of psychological interventions with parents aimed at promoting positive parenting and child development;
2. Knowledge in the application and analysis of psychological assessment tools Knowledge of the application and analysis of psychological assessment tools aimed at assessing parenting and child development and adjustment;
3. Knowledge and experience of applied research in psychology in the areas covered by the fellowship, namely child psychopathology and evidence-based psychological interventions with children and parents;
4. Knowledge and experience in quantitative and qualitative data analysis.

C. Plan of activities:

The fellow will carry out activities to support the execution of project's tasks, namely:

1. Administration of the assessment protocol;
2. Collaboration in conducting of the ACT-Raising Safe Kids program with groups of mothers and fathers in prisons;
3. Entering data into databases;
4. Collaboration in data analysis;
5. Collaboration in the writing of scientific documents (e.g., scientific reports, presentations and articles).

D. Applicable legislation and regulation:

Research Fellowship Holder Statute, approved by Law No. 40/2004, of August 18, amended by Decree-Law No. 202/2012, of August 27, by Decree-Law No. 233/2012, of October 29, by Law No. 12/2013, of January 29, by Decree-Law No. 89/2013, of July 9, by Decree-Law No. 123/2019, of August 28, and by Decree-Law No. 65/2024, of October 1; *Regulation of Research Fellowships of the University of Lisbon*, published by Order No. 6238/2020, of June 12 and amended by Order No. 8061/2022, of July 1; *FCT Regulation for Research Studentships and Fellowships*, approved by the Regulation No. 950/2019, of December 16, and amended by Regulation No. 643/2021, of July 14;.



E. Place of research activities:

The research activities will take place at the Research Center for Psychological Science of the Faculdade de Psicologia da Universidade de Lisboa and at other locations where fieldwork takes place, under the scientific supervision of Professor Ana Isabel Pereira, Associate Professor with Aggregation of the Faculdade de Psicologia da Universidade de Lisboa.

F. Duration of the fellowship:

The fellowship will last for 11 (eleven) months or until the end date of the project, and is scheduled to start in March 2026.

G. Monthly allowance:

The fellowship amounts to €1.309,64 per month, which will be adjusted according to annual update of monthly maintenance grants for scholarships carried out by FCT, I. P. in Portugal, published at <https://www.fct.pt/financiamento/programas-de-financiamento/bolsas/>. The fellowship will be paid monthly by bank transfer. In addition to this amount, there is a personal accident insurance.

The activities will be developed under exclusive dedication by the fellow, in accordance to the Article 5 of the *Statute of the Scientific Research Fellow*.

H. Selection process:

1. The selection method to be used will be the following: **Curricular Assessment (AC)**.

1.1. The **Curricular Assessment corresponds to the Final Assessment (AF)** and is expressed on a scale of 0 (0,00 minimum scale) to 20 (20,00 maximum scale), valued to the hundredths, and will be carried out by applying the following formula: **AF = AC**.

1.2. The following elements shall be considered and weighted in the **Curricular Assessment**:

- a) **Academic qualifications (HA)**;
- b) **Research and Professional Experience (PCP)**;
- c) **Adequacy of the Applicant to the Required Profile (ACPR)**.

1.3. Taking into account the characteristics of the position, the **Final Assessment (AF)** will be carried out by applying the following formula:

$$AF = 0,5 HA + 0,4 PCP + 0,1 ACPR$$

a) The **Academic Qualifications (HA)** will graduate from 10 to 20 points, according to the academic degrees the applicants can prove they hold and the quality of their previous training, as follows:

- Final classification of the Master's degree or Integrated Master's degree in the field of Child and Adolescent Developmental Psychopathology or in Clinical and Health Psychology, which will correspond to the applicant's final grade.

This criterion will be verified by analysing the certificate(s) of the degree(s).



b) The **Research and Professional Experience (PCP)** will be graded from 0 to 20 points taking into account the nature of previous activities and experience in the area of activity for which this tender is open, namely in the following criteria:

- Knowledge and experience of psychological interventions with parents aimed at promoting positive parenting and child development (10 points);
- Knowledge in the application and analysis of psychological assessment tools Knowledge of the application and analysis of psychological assessment tools aimed at assessing parenting and child development and adjustment (2 points);
- Knowledge and experience of applied research in psychology in the areas covered by the fellowship, namely child psychopathology and evidence-based psychological interventions with children and parents (5 points);
- Knowledge and experience in quantitative and qualitative data analysis (3 points).

These criteria will be verified by analysing the CV, the certificates/letters of reference presented and/or the scientific publications (or articles submitted for publication) indexed in international databases, i.e., Web of Science or Scopus.

c) The **Adequacy of the Applicant to the Required Profile (ACPR)** will be graded from 0 to 20 points taking into account the applicant's motivation and characteristics relevant to the activity for which this tender has been opened.

The verification of this criterion will be based on the analysis of the motivation letter.

- 1.4. Applicants whose application is assessed with a final classification of less than 14 points are not eligible for granting a research fellowship.
- 1.5. In the event of an equal score between candidates, preference will be given to the one whose profile is considered by the jury to be best suited to the tender position.

I. Selection Committee:

The selection committee is composed of Prof. Ana Isabel Pereira, Associate Professor with Aggregation of the Faculdade de Psicologia da Universidade de Lisboa, as **president** of the selection committee; Professor Luísa Barros, Full Professor of the Faculdade de Psicologia da Universidade de Lisboa, and Professor Ana Cristina Neves, Head of Division at the Direção-Geral de Reinserção e Serviços Prisionais and Assistant Professor of the Instituto Universitário Egas Moniz as **effective members**; and Professor Ana Isabel Gomes, Assistant Professor of the Faculdade de Psicologia da Universidade de Lisboa and Professor Sara Cardoso, Assistant Professor of the Faculdade de Psicologia da Universidade de Lisboa as **alternate members**.

J. Publication / notification of results:

The final results of the assessment will be publicised by means of a draft ranking list, posted in a visible and public place at the Faculdade de Psicologia da Universidade de Lisboa, and published on the FPUL website at <https://www.psicologia.ulisboa.pt/sobre/rh/bolsas/>. Applicants may appeal against the draft



final ranking list within 10 working days of its publication. The successful applicant will be notified by e-mail.

K. Application deadline and process:

The application period is open from the 25th February to the 10th of March 2026.

Applications must be completed by sending the following documents:

1. Application form, available at <https://www.psicologia.ulisboa.pt/sobre/rh/bolsas/>, dully filled;
2. Motivation letter;
3. Curriculum vitae;
4. Copy of certificate of the Bachelor's and Master's degree, or Integrated Master's, with the final grade;

Holders of academic degrees awarded by foreign higher education institutions must hold recognition of the academic degree required in this Public Notice in accordance with Decree-Law No. 66/2018, of August 16. **Recognition of the degrees must be obtained until the date of the contract agreement signature, if the applicant ranked in the eligible position has obtained the academic degree required in this Public Notice abroad;**

5. Copy of the proof of registration and enrolment on the course required in this Public Notice, in the scientific areas identified in point A. At the application stage, proof of registration and enrolment may be replaced by a dully complete declaration of honour available at <https://www.psicologia.ulisboa.pt/sobre/rh/bolsas/>, if applicable;

The proof of registration and enrolment must be obtained until the date of the contract agreement signature;

6. Certificate(s) or equivalent document(s) of research and professional experience;
7. Declaration of honour certifying that the applicant does not exceed, with the conclusion of the scholarship contract in question, including any renewals, an accumulated period of one year in this type of scholarship, consecutively or interpolated, available at <https://www.psicologia.ulisboa.pt/sobre/rh/bolsas/>, dully filled;
8. Other elements that the applicant considers relevant to the application (e.g., reference letters; publications or papers submitted to publication with proof of submission).

NB: the applicants who do not send in all of the above documents will be excluded.
